If you answered YES, we invite you to apply to participate in the annual AERA ROGCT Gifted Connection, a **mentorship opportunity** that will take place during the 2019 AERA annual meeting in Toronto, Canada.

This program is a great way for **graduate students to network** with experts in the giftedness, creativity, and talent field. Mentors and mentees are matched according to similar research and career interests. Mentoring pairs meet for approximately one hour during AERA and can talk about everything from research to career advice. Mentors are reimbursed up to \$20 for coffee, snacks, etc.
